Technology Transfer Centre (TTC) will be established at the University of Novi Sad (UNS), Serbia, as an organizational unit within the Rectorate. Prof. Veljko Malbasa, the contact person for the University of Novi Sad, had a meeting with the Prof. Miroslav Veskovic, Rector, and they agreed that the Senate of the University of Novi Sad will adopt the legal documents to establish the TTC. Prof. Veljko Malbasa will prepare and submit to the Senate the draft act to set up TTC and the draft of TTC regulations by September 2012.

TTC will be located at the Faculty of Technical Sciences, Room F319, Trg Dositeja Obradovica 6, 21000 Novi Sad. The room is very convenient, with all necessary infrastructure (furniture, internet access, phone, air conditioning). Once the new Rectorate building is completed at the UNS campus, the TTC will move to the permanent premises at the Rectorate building.

TTC will host the equipment purchased within the scheme of Tempus KNOWTS project. The equipment will be used during the life time of the project to support ongoing TTC activities, and will provide a platform for the sustainable activities after the project is completed.

Ms. Maja Kondic, administrative assistant for the international projects, Faculty of Technical Sciences, will be a responsible person for the TTC. Ms. Kondic has been included in the project activities at the UNS from the very beginning of the project and she has all the necessary background to successfully perform the TTC activities (master degree in business and fluency in English language). Ms. Kondic will attend the training courses which will be organized under the auspices of the Tempus KNOWTS project.
